



Update of APN activities



- ✓ Implementing APN 3rd Strategic Plan (2010-2015), necessary to enhance science-policy interaction
- ✓ 2011 APCP / CAPaBLE project evaluation process, soon completed
- ✓ 2012 ARCP /CAPaBLE process will start in a couple of months
- ✓ New programs to support “Low Carbon” and “Adaptation” are launching (beneficial to UNFCCC/COP16/17 agreements)

Key for Success



- How scientific knowledge can be successfully incorporated into national adaptation plans
 - Initiatives by developing countries
 - Localization, Continuity
- Necessary for streamlining? Re-grouping in sub-region / sectors?
 - Sub-regional cooperation (e.g., SA, SEA)
 - Adaptation in coastal mega-cities (input to city planning)
 - Better water resource management in agriculture (hi-resolution and short-term projection necessary for hydropower construction plan)

- Identify prioritized activities which should be supported by APN in regional or sub-regional scale, and

- Bring scientists, policy-makers and practitioners associated with adaptation together in one venue – both within and outside the APN member countries
